

## **Minutes of Meeting – AGM of EOEW, New Delhi**

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Ex-ONGC Executive Welfare Association (EOEW), New Delhi was held on Saturday, 28th March 2026 at Scope Complex Convention Centre, Lodhi Road, New Delhi from 10:30 Hrs onwards. Quorum was present at the scheduled time of AGM.

### **Agenda item - 1**

- a. Proceedings commenced by observing silence for 2 minutes to pay homage to all those members who had left for heavenly abode since last meeting.

### **Agenda item - 2**

Activity Report for the period August 2025 to March 2026 was presented by Shri Amit Narayan, Joint Secretary. The report highlighted various activities and initiatives undertaken by the Association during the period for the welfare and engagement of members. Activity report covered following major events:

- a. Celebration of 70th Foundation Day of ONGC and the 79th Independence Day of India. ## **Agenda item - 6**


Following the approval of accounts, members who had attained the milestone age of 80 years and above were felicitated by the Association in recognition of their valuable association and contribution over the years.
