MINUTES OF MEETING OF EC-E0EWA HELD ON 15.02.2023

The EC meeting of Ex ONGC Executives Welfare Association was held on 15.2.2023 at ONGC, Scope Minar, Laxmi Nagar Delhi at 11 a.m.

The meeting began with a Welcome address by Sh. K.S. Randhawa, Secy and by congratulating all members on joining the EC. Thereafter President EC Sh. Ashok Varma conveyed his best wishes to all the EC members and expressed happiness over the presence of EC members in full strength. He stated that the objective of the EOEWA is to serve the retired employees who all are quite senior in age, have various kinds of problems and often no one to help. We must always be respectful towards them irresepective of the level at which they retired or the condition in which they may be now. At the same time this noble cause needs to be carried out while balancing out our responsibilities towards our own family members. This can be achieved by creating a culture of positivity and mutual respect within the team. Working together towards a common goal without criticism of team members and promoting cohesiveness in the group will go a longway in building trust amongst retired employees.

Sh. Varma briefed about various issues to be discussed in the meeting.

- 1. President-EC emphasised that retirees have a range of concerns and questions. So it is important to respond promptly and thoughtfully to their queries . They post their queries mostly through whatsapp and sometimes on email. The queries are related to EPS, various orders, medical and other welfare facilities. Whatsapp group of EOEWA is the convenient platform for retirees to raise queries. The responsibility of replying to queries of retirees was assigned to Sh. Rajiv Bansal and
- 2. he was made Admin of the group EOEWA Delhi. He may consult other EC members with regard to any query. President-EC also appreciated the efforts of Sh. Bansal in promptly and accurately replying to the queries of retirees on various issues. The Email of EOEWA is eoewadelhi@gmail.com which will be handled by Shri Sanjay Chawla and Shri GK Valecha.
- 3. President -EC brought out that revamping or updating of the website (exongcexecutives.org) can be a great way to improve its functionality. The responsibility was assigned to Sh.S.K. Batra with support from Shri Shiv Dayal, and Ms. Sunita Khanna for updating the contents of the website and uploading of various relevant orders/circulars.
- 4. President stated that there are many retirees who come from other stations for treatment, and some are living alone. They sometimes need immediate help during medical emergencies. It was discussed that the areas amongst Committee members as per their residential location may be divided. Committee members in their respective zone will identify few retired employees who are

willing to volunteer for extending necessary help to the retirees in case of emergencies. Arrangement of vehicle/ambulance may be done officially through ONGC. Contact person in case of emergencies will be Sh. Randhawa, Secy EC, who will further delegate the responsibility to the EC member of the particular area to contact the retiree needing help.

- 5. The responsibility of communication with SEE section with regard to various issues of retirees has been assigned to Ms. Sunita Khanna. She will contact SEE section to look into various matters or claims in case no satisfactory reply is received by the retiree. Ms. Khanna explained that incessant phone calls cause disturbance in the working of SEE section so timings will be fixed by discussing with Incharge SEE for such communications.
- 6. EC meeting arrangements, like booking of Conference hall, Tea, Lunch etc will be taken care by Sh. K.S. Randhawa, Secy. EC
- 7. General body meeting arrangements will be collectively handled by Sh. Sh.K.S. Randhawa, Secy, Sh. Shiv Dayal, Treasurer and Sh. V.B. Soneja, EC Member
- 8. President-EC suggested that Since an office space has been allotted in SEE section for EC members, two EC members should visit office once in fortnight to maintain the working of the office. This can be a valuable opportunity to connect with colleagues and stay informed about important developments. This was agreed by all EC members.
- 9. Sh. V.K. Singh, DGM(HR) -scope minar administration was requested to make arrangement for parking of the vehicles of EC members during their visit to the office. He agreed to it and assured for doing the needful.
- 10. EC members informed that of late, Excursion trips arranged by EOEWA have been a big success. The interaction and enjoyment during these trips has generated cohesiveness amongst the retired community. With the consent of President and all EC members, It was decided to arrange at least three excursion trips in a year. one trip within Delhi NCR, one trip within India, and one trip abroad. While the Associtaion may partly fund the expenses for the tour within NCR, the other two shall be strictly on self contribution basis. Sh.S.K. Batra, Executive Member and Shri HPS Ahuja, Vice President shall scout for such trips and once they shortlist some such tours, other executive members shall be included to further plan, arrange and execute such programs successfully.
- 11. The EC members agreed unanimously to co-opt Sh. N.K. Sidana, Ex.GM(F&A), membership No. 630, for pre-auditing of accounts, maintaining books of accounts in proper format etc to support existing Treasurer Sh. Shiv Dayal.
- 12. It was suggested by Sh.Shiv Dayal, Treasurer to obtain a letter from Sh. A.K. Hazarika, Ex. President EOEWA regarding attestation of the signatures authorised signatories (President, Vice President, Gen.Secy and Treasurer). The needful will be done by the Treasurer.
- 13. It was suggested by Sh. Varma, President EC that all EC members should meet CMD ONGC to introduce themselves and also to put forth various issues raised from time to time by various members, such as:
 - (i) Revision of Asha Kiran amount
 - (ii) Revision of Agrani Samman
 - (iii) Cataract -Lens amount revision
 - (iv) Dental Implants reimbursement
 - (v) Blood test strips reimbursement
 - (vi) Nursing charges for handicapped dependents
 - (vii) Old age home for senior citizens above 70 yrs of age at ONGC colonies
 - (viii) Involvement of Ex-ongicians in ONGC day and National day programmes
 - (ix) Corporate rates for hotels, flights for retirees
 - (x) Ex-ONGCians may be given access to ONGC reports for viewing only
 - (xi) Newspapers to be timely uploaded in bandhan site
