

Record notes of discussions of the Executive Committee Meeting

Held on 8th July 2026

The meeting of EC of Ex ONGC Executives Welfare Association (EOEWA) was held on 8th July 2026 at 6th floor, Scope complex, Laxmi Nagar, New Delhi.

A. Agenda points discussed

1. EC was apprised by Gen Secretary that mementoes of those members who attained age of 80+ during last AGM held on 28th March 2026 would be despatched to those members through courier shortly.

2. EC discussed that like past years, this year too ONGC day celebrations are to be organised during month of August 2026. In this regard following decisions were taken:
 - a. ONGC day is to be celebrated on 22nd August 2026 (Saturday) at Scope Convention Centre, Lodhi Road.

- b. Gen. Secretary informed EC that request for booking of auditorium for 22nd August 2026 has already been submitted. Request would be sent by Gen Secretary to Head Coordination, ONGC for making other arrangements.
- c. It was also decided to felicitate those members of EOEWa who have attained age of 90 yrs +. House was informed by Sh Shiv Dayal telephonically that list of 5 such members has already been prepared and shared. Arrangement of necessary number of shawls and plaque for felicitation is to be made accordingly.
- d. EC discussed that in view of majority of members being senior citizens, it would be prudent to make some seating arrangement in dining hall during networking tea and lunch.
- e. EC also decided to hire a professional party for cultural program for entertainment of members after official proceedings. It was suggested to contact and finalise good troupe for the same.
- f. It was also decided to organise a talk by some renowned Doctor or good speaker on Health & Lifestyle for benefit of members.
- g. Distribution of sweet packets to the members as per past practice was also agreed upon by EC.

- 3. House was also informed that 5th edition of quarterly newsletters being issued by EOEWa for the period Jan – June'26 would be prepared and released by 15th July 2026.

- 4. EC discussed other options to organise get-together for members in the month of Oct/Nov in lieu of outdoor picnic which is being organised on similar format for past few years. In this regard following decisions were taken:
 - a. Dinner for interested members with spouse to be organised in a banquet hall at some convenient location before commencement of wedding season.
 - b. Tentative dates for the event was suggested as 1st Nov'26.
 - c. To ascertain total numbers, it was decided that some contribution to be taken from members beforehand, amount of which to be decided once cost implications are worked out.
 - d. EC also suggested that since purpose of this event is to provide networking opportunity to members, a small band to be hire just to play soft instrumental music.

5. Recent circulars on medical facilities and their implication on superannuated members were also discussed in detail. Inconvenience being faced by members for collecting original hard copy of reference for PME or credit note for Pathological tests especially by those in higher age bracket or living far away from ONGC establishments was also put forward. Various options were discussed to simplify this procedure to avoid unnecessary travel by retired ONGCians to ONGC offices. In this regard EC decided that;
 - a. A communication may be prepared to be sent to ONGC management highlighting the issue and possible solution.
 - b. It was also discussed to suggest in letter to provide facility to generate request by superannuated employees either through ONGC Cares app or Bandhan website, based on which, ONGC Doctors can prepare reference and mail directly to hospital with a copy to beneficiary by e-mail or post.

6. President EOEWAA also raised the issue of only one Patron presently available due to sad demise of 2 patrons in past few years. EC deliberated this matter at length and suggested that President may speak and request Sh R S Sharma, Former CMD, Sh Atul Chandra, Former MD, ONGC Videsh and Sh Jauhari Lal, Former Director (HR) for their consent for nomination as patron.

7. Travel committee apprised EC regarding status of cancelled trip to Europe planned during April 2026 due to conflict in West Asia.
 - a. EC was informed that total 3 groups were formed of 33-35 members each out of which 2 groups were awarded to M/S Trip Factory & 3rd group to M/s Trip Arcade.
 - b. Based on the chat poll, around 35 members out of total 104 opted for deferment of trip to revised proposed date of mid June'26 and rest others opted for refund.

- c. However, while seeking confirmation again to fix travel during first fortnight of June'26 most of the members opted out. Hence, trip to Europe stands cancelled as of now.
- d. Based on continuous discussions by Travel committee, both the operators agreed as under:
 - i. M/s Trip Factory (For Group 1 & 2) informed that out of Rs 35,000/= deposited per head, there would be a deduction of Rs 25,000/- on account of cancellation of hotels, air ticket & visa assistance already provided and balance Rs 10,000/- would be refunded.
 - ii. M/s Trip Arcade (Group-3) offered a deduction of Rs 13000/= per head and refund of Rs 22,000/- per head. Also, this operator had taken 2nd instalment amounting to Rs 1,40,000/- which has been refunded recently.
 - iii. Refund process for balance amount has been initiated for group 1 & 2 and would commence soon for group 3 and is likely to be over within a week.
 - iv. EC expressed concern on difference in amount deducted due to engagement of 2 different operators. It was decided by EC that henceforth, only one operator with best offer would be engaged for all the groups for a destination to avoid any variation in terms and conditions or quality of services.
 - v. EC also decided to refund amount of Rs 1,000/= collected per head initially by EOEWa as this trip could not materialise. It was agreed that amount would be released in favour of one of the EC member who would ensure transfer of fund to all members as per the list and submit details to treasurer.
 - vi. It was also decided that in future, such refunds would only be made in case entire trip is cancelled and not for individual cancellations or drop-outs.
 - vii. EC advised travel committee to plan for a short low budget tour to a domestic or International destination after monsoon.

Meeting concluded with EC members thanking President & Vice Presidents for their guidance to ensure constant engagement with the members.
